- Estimate \$6 million Saskatchewan share from Ottawa
 - 1) Gas Tax

 - 2) Provincial/Territorial Infrastructure Fund (PTIF)
 - Application based, same level money as 2009 but spread over ten years.
 - 3) GST Rebates
 - 4) P3 Canada

- 2) Tax Enforcement Regulations re: Mediation Board threshold values
