<u>CALL TO ORDER:</u> President Chris Costley called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

INTRODUCTIONS: President Costley welcomed special guests.

A round table introduction took place.

#### ORDER OF DISCUSSIONS:

### **CAO & Council Relationships**

- Requirements for Council Training, particularly roles and responsibilities.
- Working towards the challenges in these relationships
  - Councilors come in with no real experience
  - Province to see if there is some way to get Councils to take some kind of training within the first 6-12 months of being elected. (ex: 30 minute video)
- No mandatory trainings for any elective positions (ie: MLAs, school boards, etc).
- o Mandatory education for Councilors? Gov't? SUMA?
- Suggest SUMA (possibly) to make and distribute standardization videos for municipalities to use to help administrators with training their Councils.
- Could SUMA/SARM resolutions help to get the training?
   'Mandatory' is the difficult word.
- Protection of CAO tenure suggestions: 2/3 requirement to release someone; right to appear before Council to present position.

#### Census Appeals

- o How many Census appeals did the government receive?
- Will the new appealed numbers be used in the municipal revenue sharing, Gas Tax fund, policing costs, etc.?
  - Yes those numbers come into effect the following year after the appeals are decided.
- Could all organizations (SUMA/SARM/UMAAS/RMAA, etc.) partner to educate the public on how the Census is important to their communities?

### <u>Elections Date – Provincial/Municipal Election</u>

- o Why is the date not changed?
- Municipal Election and Provincial Election are too aligned? Too close together.
- There was no consensus among the municipalities to agree on a specific election date.

### Infrastructure Funding

- o Per capita is good funding.
- o Revenue Sharing is a good program.
- Infrastructure challenges: municipalities need to move to resolve infrastructure challenges on a cost recovering basis.

### Salary Guidelines – 2023

- o 2023 is a challenging year.
- CPI is at 6%; typically we go around 2%, but that likely won't cut it this year.
- Any advice? Difficult to answer as all levels of government in the same boat.
- o Many use CPI, RMAA & UMAAS Guideline; RMAA has increased to 6.8%.
- Various percentages around the room UMAAS recommendation is 3.9%;
- SUMA regional meeting issues include recruitment and retention of administrators.

## <u>Ukrainian Refugees</u>

- Sask. has accepted more refugees than Canada does.
- o Just need a welcoming province.
- Need for more Provincial/local autonomy
- Certification of registered nurses in Saskatchewan and across Canada.
